From our Meteorologists:

Lingering influence of large wildfires in southern California plus the local Lovell Canyon fire could push ozone levels into the Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups range today. The weather pattern is changing to a "monsoon" pattern with moisture coming from the south. If the local fire is controlled today the ozone and fine particle levels should improve tomorrow.
